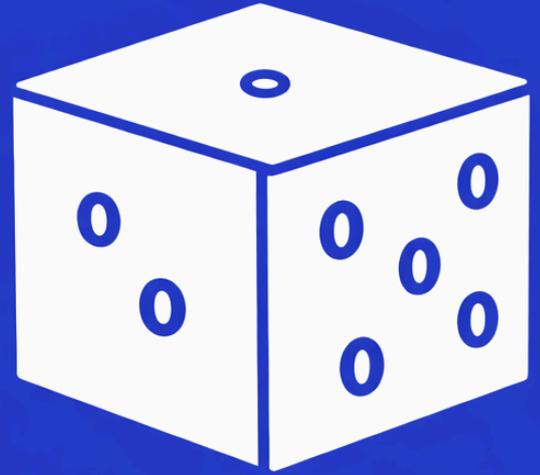

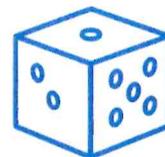

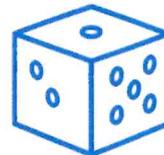
5 Write 2.3 litres in millilitres.

$$1\text{L} = 1000\text{ml}$$

$$2.3 \times 1000$$

2300ml

6 Sam and Priya run a half-marathon race.

(a) Sam starts the race at **10:40 am**.

He takes $2\frac{1}{4}$ hours to finish the race.

At what time does he finish?

2 hours = 120 minutes

$\frac{1}{4} = 0.25$ hours = 15 minutes

He takes 2 hours and 15 minutes

10:40 + 2 hours = 12:40

12:40 + 15 minutes = 12:55

.....
12:55pm

(b) Priya has a target time of **3 hours 45 minutes**.

She has been running for **142 minutes**.

To meet her target, how many **minutes** does she have left to finish the race?

$3 \times 60 = 180$ minutes

$180 + 45 = 225$ minutes (target)

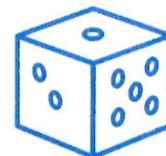
Already run 142 minutes

$\therefore 225 - 142 = 83$ minutes

.....
83 minutes

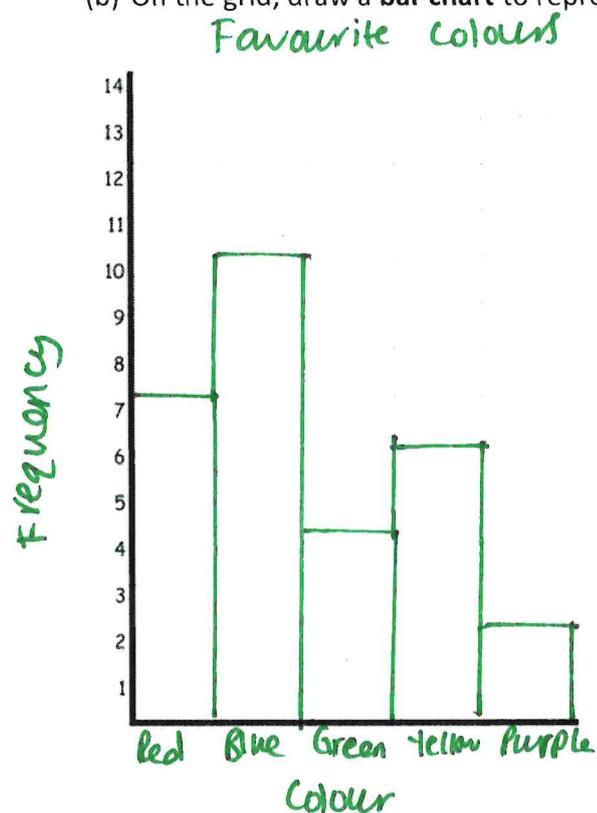
7 Here is a tally chart that shows the favourite colours of some pupils:

Colour	Tally	Frequency
Red		7
Blue		10
Green		4
Yellow		6
Purple		2

(a) Complete the frequency column.

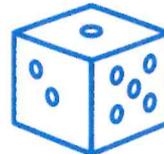

$$7v - 4v = 3v$$
$$+2w + w = +3w$$

(b) Solve $5k + 3 = 11$

$$-3 \quad -3$$
$$\div 5 \left(\begin{array}{l} 5k = 8 \\ k = \frac{8}{5} \end{array} \right) \div 5$$

$$\underline{\hspace{10em} \frac{8}{5} \text{ or } 1.6 \hspace{10em}}$$

9 Daisy worked for **38 hours** last week and was paid **£18.50 per hour**.

Estimate her weekly earnings

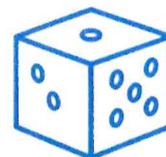
$$38 \rightarrow 40$$
$$£18.50 \rightarrow £20.00$$

$$40 \times 20 = 800$$

$$\underline{\hspace{10em} £800 \hspace{10em}}$$

10 Complete the list of six numbers so that:

- The **mode** is 7
- The **median** is 10
- The **range** is 9

Write your numbers in **order**:

7, 7, 10, 10, 7, 16

Range = 9 \therefore Largest = $16 - ? = 9 = (7)$

Mode = 7 (Most Common number)

Median = 10

$$\frac{\text{3rd number} + \text{4th number}}{2} = 10$$

3rd number = 10

4th number = 10

Mode = 7

Median = 10

Range = 9

11 Daniel travels 7.5 miles in 12 minutes.

Work out his average speed in miles per hour.

$$\frac{12}{60} = 0.2 \text{ hours}$$

$$S = \frac{d}{t} = \frac{7.5}{0.2} = 37.5$$

37.5 mph

12 Work out $\frac{5}{8} + \frac{13}{24}$

Give your answer as a **mixed number**.

$$\frac{5}{8} = \frac{5 \times 3}{8 \times 3} = \frac{15}{24}$$

$$\frac{15}{24} + \frac{13}{24} = \frac{28}{24} = \frac{7}{6} = 1\frac{1}{6}$$

$1\frac{1}{6}$

(Total for Question 12 is 2 marks)

13 James has a rectangular floor that is **10 m long** and **6 m wide**.

He wants to cover the floor completely with **carpet tiles**.

Each carpet tile is a square with sides of **40 cm**.

Each carpet tile costs **£3.75**.

Work out the **total cost** of covering the floor completely with carpet tiles.

$$\text{Area} = 10 \times 6 = 60 \text{ m}^2$$

$$40 \text{ cm} = 0.4 \text{ m}$$

$$\text{Tile Area} = 0.4 \times 0.4 = 0.16 \text{ m}^2$$

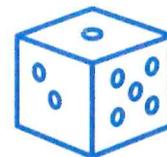
$$\frac{60}{0.16} = 375 \text{ tiles}$$

$$375 \times 3.75 = \pounds 1406.25$$

$\pounds 1406.25$

14 50% of a number is 20.

Work out 180% of the number.

$$\frac{1}{2} \times x = 20$$

$$\text{Number} = 40$$

$$1.8 \times 40 = 72$$

72

(Total for Question 14 is 3 marks)

15 Ava has £120.

She gives 75% of her money to Ethan.

Ethan spends $\frac{1}{3}$ of this money.

He gives the rest back to Ava.

What fraction of the £120 does Ava have now?

Give your answer in its simplest form.

$$75\% = \frac{75}{100} = \frac{3}{4}$$

$$\frac{90}{120} = \frac{3}{4}$$

$$\frac{3}{4} \times 120 = 90$$

$$120 - 90 = 30$$

$$\frac{1}{3} \times 90 = 30$$

$$90 - 30 = 60$$

$$60 + 30 = 90$$

Ava now has £90

$\frac{3}{4}$
